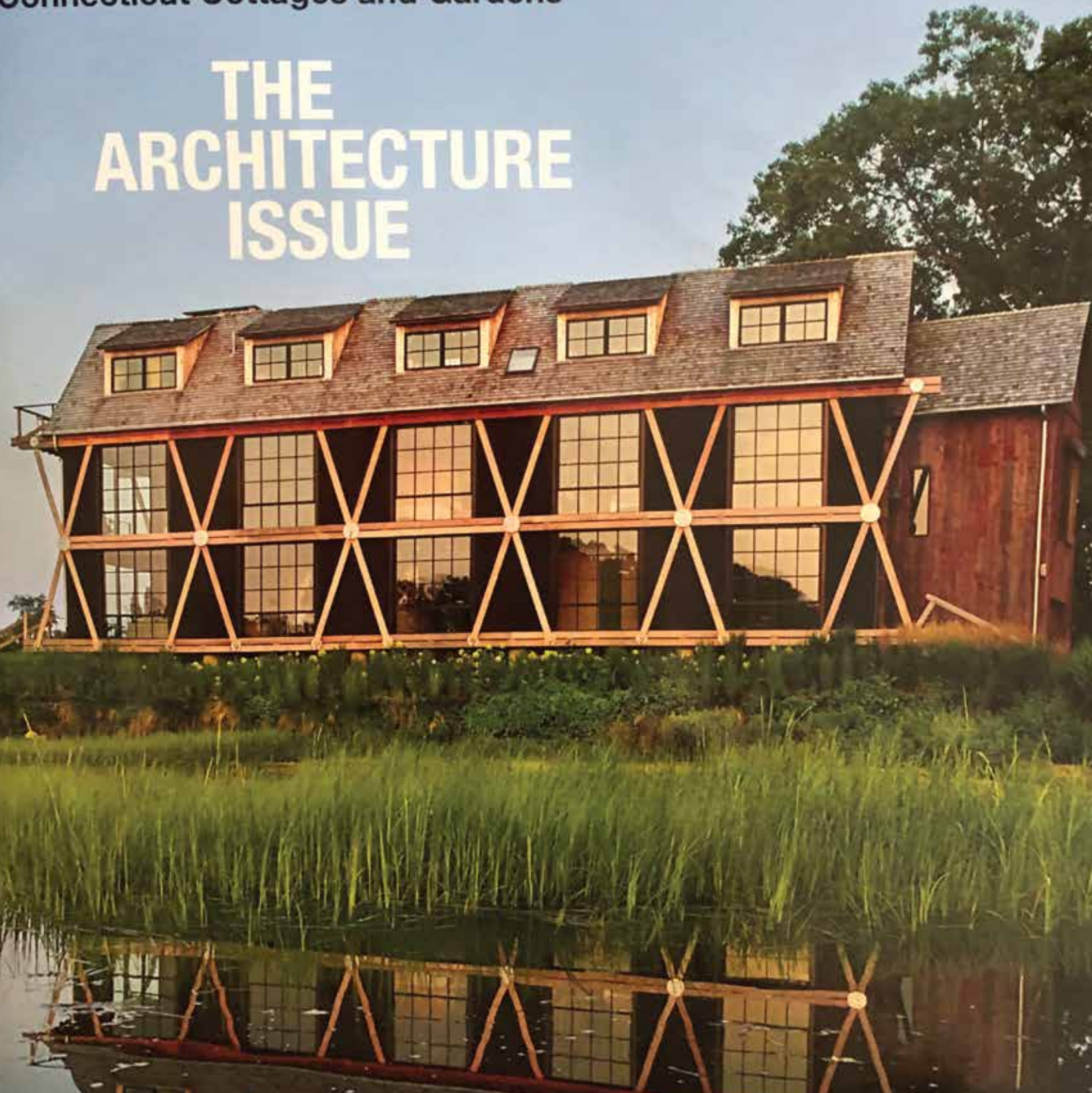

**A**CCORDING TO SHOPIFY, A "POP-UP shop" is a short-term, temporary retail event that is "here today, gone tomorrow." Once confined to popular seasonal destinations, such as the Hamptons, pop-up shops are *abem*—popping up all over. ■ At January's Deco Off in Paris, during which furnishings and fabrics companies invited editors, design professionals and the public to view their brand-new wares, one such pop-up stood out for its creativity and variety of participating brands. Set up to suggest an elegant train compartment on the *Orient Express*, the Ancien et Moderne salon featured glamorous wall coverings, fabrics and rugs, a handcrafted bed, an inlaid cabinet, sumptuous glassware and fine luggage—all accoutrements of luxury travel.
